

COVID-SAFE PLAN

Business Name: Karting Madness

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Karting Madness wants to assure their customers that we have a Covid-19 Safety plan which is in line with current Victorian Government public health orders.

We are committed to the safety and wellbeing of our team members and our customers.

We ask that you comply with the following requirements if visiting and help us in keeping everyone safe!

1. Ensure Physical Distancing

- Floor markings in reception and café area.
- Signage around the venue to remind staff members and customers of the social distancing requirements.
- Furniture rearranged in common areas to ensure physical distancing of patrons.
- Bookings reminded on the phone and on arrival to comply with social distancing requirements within the venue.
- All of our Karting Madness staff has returned to work however only the minimum number of employees necessary to safely operate our venue will be present to ensure social distancing and minimal numbers are in place.
- A maximum of 10 participants per group on track.
- Once your race has finished we do require you to leave the area through the exit closest to pit lane, as we can only have limited numbers at any one time.
- Multiple groups are permitted at our venue at the same time, providing all attendees are reasonably capable of maintaining a distance of 1.5m from each other.

2. Wearing a face covering

- Face masks are now mandatory inside our venue.
- Track marshalls do not need to wear masks while marshalling.
- Masks are not required while racing as drivers will be wearing a helmet and not in contact with other drivers.

3. Practise good hygiene

- Sanitiser is provided throughout the venue.
- We have increased our already high level of cleaning with more frequent cleaning schedules.
- Please ensure you practice good hygiene by washing your hands and using the sanitiser provided.
- Installation of contactless soap dispensers and dryers.
- Weekly inventory of required cleaning supplies.
- Regular restock of cleaning items.
- High touch surfaces (touch screens, handles, kitchen counters) are cleaned regularly.
- BYO Helmet is advisable – If you have your own Australian standard approved helmet please bring it along. Balaclava's are available to purchase for \$4.00 or BYO if you have one. All hire helmets are properly cleaned and sanitised as per Covid-19 regulations. New Helmets can also be purchased from the front desk.

4. Keep records and act quickly if workers become unwell

- If you are feeling unwell please stay at home. Anyone showing signs of illness will be immediately asked to leave.
- Karting Madness requires all visitors to scan the QR code at the front desk.
- Bookings are preferred.
- Downloading the 'Activity Box' app and Registering on the app (new drivers only)
- All drivers will have their phone number confirmed at the front desk to ensure it is up to date.

5. Avoid interactions in enclosed spaces

- Front door remains open and track fans are turned on to enhance airflow

6. Create workforce bubbles

- Staff rostered on their regular shifts
- Staggered start and finish times, shift and break times to ensure minimal use of common areas at the same time
